

IMMUFELLOW Postdoctoral Fellowships 2026

Up to 11 positions at the University of Turku (UTU), and
Åbo Akademi University (ÅAU), Turku, Finland



About the programme

The Interdisciplinary and Intersectoral Research Fellowship Programme for Future Leaders in Immunology (**IMMUFELLOW**) is a 3-year postdoctoral training initiative jointly run by UTU and ÅAU. IMMUFELLOW is partly funded by the **EU's Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) COFUND**. The programme will train future leaders in immunology, supporting innovative research in immunology-related areas such as basic, translational, and clinical immunology, diagnostics, drug development, vaccine research, health technology, or health economics.



Who can apply?

- Researchers with a **PhD awarded within the past 10 years** (excluding career breaks).
- Must **not have lived or worked in Finland for more than 12 months** in the past 3 years (MSCA mobility rule)
- Open to all nationalities and research disciplines related to immunology
- Applicants must design their own research project hosted at UTU or ÅAU

- Fully funded 3-year fellowship
- International, interdisciplinary research community
- Mentoring and career development support
- Excellent training opportunities beyond academia
- Based in **Turku, Finland** — a leading hub of immunological science and innovation



Key details

- **Duration:** 3 years (starting April/May 2027).
- **Gross salary:** ~€4,500/month + allowances
 - Mobility: €100/month
 - Family: €100/month (if eligible)
 - Research/travel/training funding available
- **Positions:** Up to 11 (9 at UTU, 2 at ÅAU)
